

Answers

Below is the corrected paragraph. The correct answers are shown in red. There is a guide in blue to where you can find more information about the grammar points in this paragraph. All information can either be found in the 'How to Use Verb Tenses in Business' book or from lessons in the Fluency Space Academy.

From the door, you can see the whole flat except the bed, which **is located** (See 'How to Use Verb Tenses in Business' Lesson 11) directly above the kitchen area. On the right, there is a small shower next to a toilet. The area is so small that you could feasibly make dinner in the kitchen **while sitting** (See Lesson 'Key Verb Patterns and General Patterns') on the toilet.

I spent the night at a place called Shanti Casa, in Tokyo, a solution for young people who can't afford the city's high rent prices, which **are increasing / have increased / have been increasing** (See 'How to Use Verb Tenses in Business' Lessons 1, 3 and 5) even higher due to the current inflation crisis in the country. The micro-apartment is just **a 9m² room** (See 'a' and 'the' Lesson) with white walls and a large window.

I stayed in one of these flats **for 24 hours** (See 'How to Use Verb Tenses in Business' Lesson 4). I spent the night alone. **Due to the fact that** (See Lesson 'Key Verb Patterns and General Patterns') the bed was above the kitchen area, I was afraid of falling from the bed onto the floor, but it didn't happen thankfully! I have to confess that I actually felt quite **relaxed** (See 'ing' / 'ed' Adjectives Lesson), but I think that I would soon become unhappy with the lack of space **if I had to** (See 'How to Use Verb Tenses in Business' Lesson 13) live here long-term.
