The Shrinking of France's Highest Mountain

France's highest mountain, Mont Blanc, shrinks at a rate of around 13cm per year. Since 2021, the mountain shrinks by 2.22m, which sounds like quite a lot, but according geologists this should be of no concern. The current shrinking of Mont Blanc certainly does not mean that this process will continue in a long-term basis. The main variation in the height generally stems from the amount of ice and snow at the summit, meaning that some years can see variations of up to 5 metres. Of course, we are used to hear about the effects of global warming on snow in mountain ranges, but the changes in the height of the mountain can also be causing by other factors such as high winds and the rate of precipitation. A higher peak would have been recorded in the winter of 2022 if we would receive stronger precipitation and lower winds.

Regardless of the official height of the mountain, it is certainly worth to climb to the top in order to see the magnificent views from the summit!
