Italy's Other Leaning Tower: Fears that Bologna's Garisenda Tower Could Collapse

A medieval tower in the Italian city of Bologna, which leans by as much as the famous tower in Pisa, **has been closed off** (See 'How to Use Verb Tenses in Business' Lesson 3) due to fears that it could soon collapse.

The tower **has been leaning** (See 'How to Use Verb Tenses in Business' Lesson 4) since the 14th century, but last October sensors recorded some slight changes in the angle of the building, suggesting that it is in danger of falling.

After extensive discussions, authorities have **made the decision** (See 'Key Prepositions and Collocations' Lesson) to build a high barrier around the tower just in case it **falls** (See 'How to Use Verb Tenses in Business' Lesson 2).
