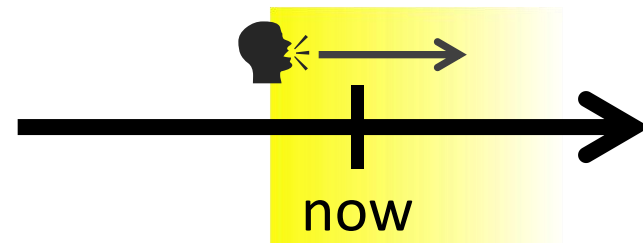


Mixing Verb Tenses: Year-End Bonuses!

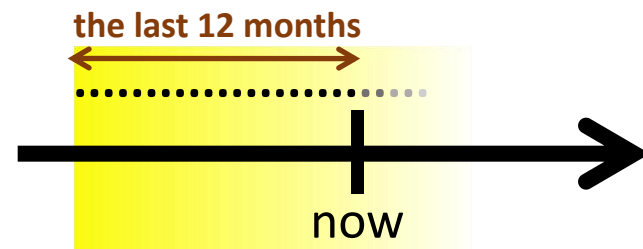
I've told the staff that they will all receive big year-end bonuses

Present Perfect because you have told them but they have not received bonuses yet.
'will' to talk about future offer not yet fulfilled.



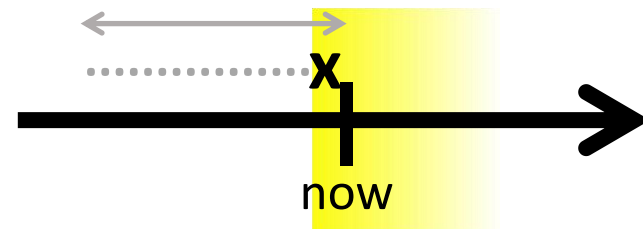
because they have all been working so hard over the last 12 months,

Present Perfect Continuous focusing on the duration and process of something continuing up to now.



and they have all hit their targets.

Present Perfect Simple for the same situation as above but focusing on the result this time instead of the duration and process.



Next week we're having a big Christmas party to celebrate.

Present Continuous to talk about a fixed future plan.
