Did you ever hear of Irish wine?

Ireland certainly isn't a traditional hotspot for fine wines, but vineyards start to spring up across the country. Due to climate change, the conditions for growing of grapes are now fairly favourable in

northern countries. The average temperature overall for Ireland increased by 0.7 degrees Celsius, thus increasing the overall growing season from seven to 16 days.



One of the country's longest-established wine producer is David Llewellyn, who is growing grapes for decades on his fruit farm less than half an hour north of Dublin: *"It started as a kind of side-hustle, but now it becomes a significant source of income. Nobody will ever retire rich from Irish wine, but I will never stop to produce it because I have a real passion for the vines."*
